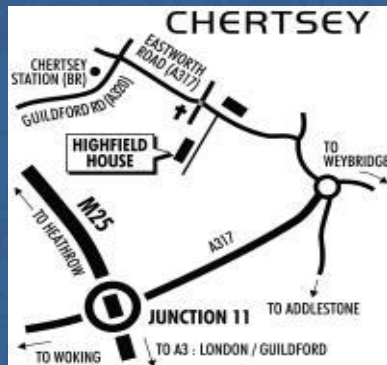


When? 23rd-24th March 2013
