Meals: Please bring a packed lunch and supper or get your meals from one of the restaurants or fast food places nearby.

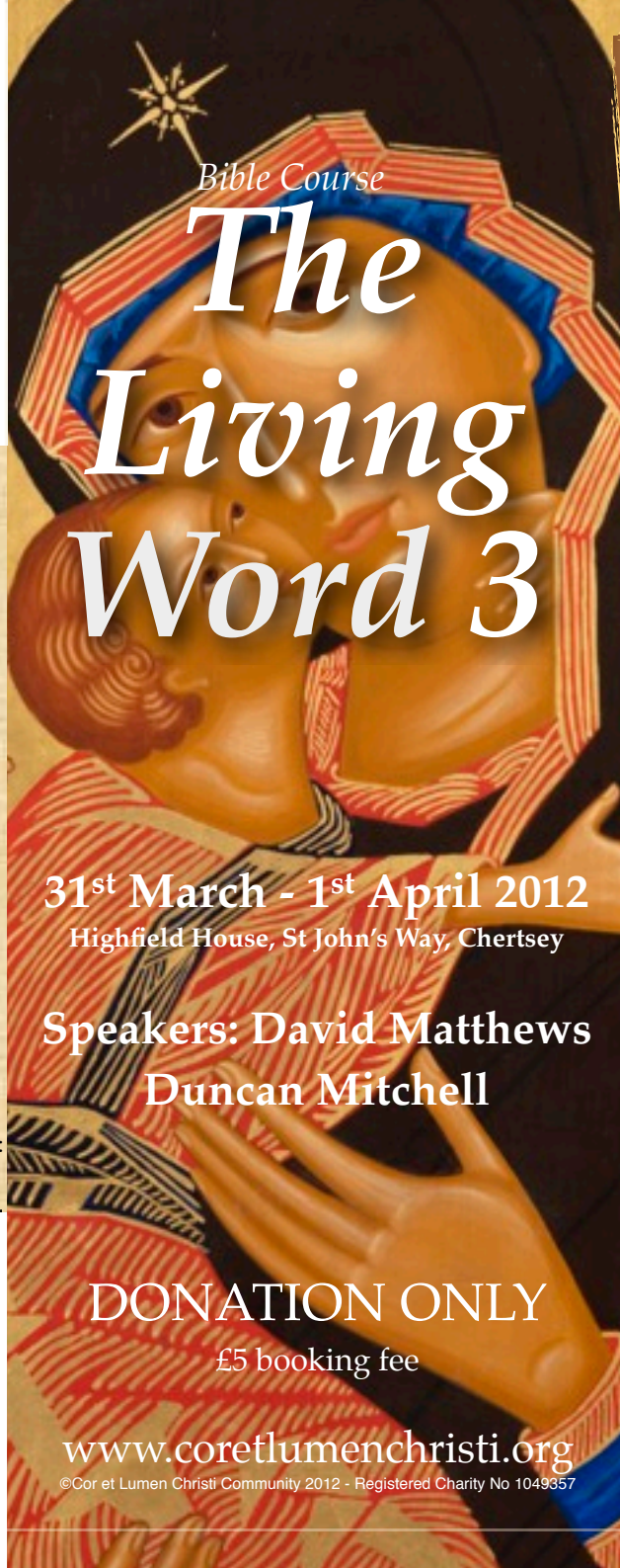
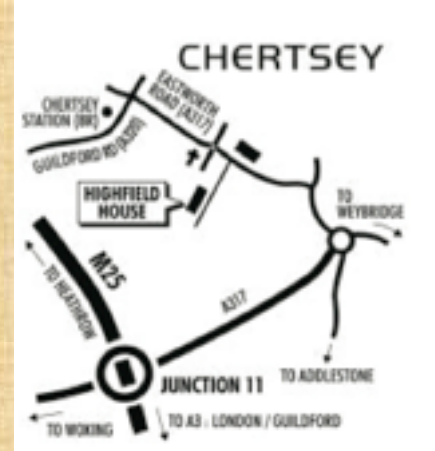
