




The Speakers

David Matthews was for his entire adult working life an evangelical charismatic protestant pastor and preacher, highly regarded by his peers. David, who has ministered in many countries, is a gifted Bible teacher with strong prophetic gifts and preaches with great humour. A man of great personal integrity and courage he founded the very first ecumenical community in Northern Ireland in the height of the troubles. David was received into the Catholic Church at Easter 2011. It will be our privilege to have him with us again.



Father Pat Deegan is an gifted and engaging preacher who is both knowledgeable and entertaining. Currently the parish priest of Our Lady and St. Alphonsus parish in Moss Side and Old Trafford, his outstanding work is bringing transformation and renewal to a deprived inner city area. After his ordination in 1990 he obtained a Master's degree from the Franciscan University, Steubenville, in 1996 and a post graduate certificate in Formative Spirituality in 1998. Fr Pat was Spiritual Director, counsellor, and lecturer at Ushaw College in Durham for six years before he moved to Moss Side in 2002.



Duncan Mitchell has been a member of the Cor et Lumen Christi Community for over 12 years. After graduating with a degree in Law, Duncan qualified as a social worker and for a number of years specialised in work with drug and alcohol users. He has an MA in Biblical Studies and is the author of the Bible Courses. Duncan is a gifted speaker and speaks regularly at Community-led events.
