

She has written various books including: *The Wild Gospel*, *Doing what Jesus did - a fresh look at the gifts of the Spirit*, and *The Word on the Wind - renewing confidence in the gospel*. She is married to Roger, and they have three children.

Fr Terry Martin was ordained for the diocese of Arundel & Brighton in 1989 by (then) Bishop Cormac Murphy-O'Connor. Previously he had studied music (flute, piano and singing) in London and this remains one of his greatest loves. After working in parishes throughout the diocese he was appointed Vocation Director in 2011. In this role, his work involves helping men and women discern God's call in their lives and he particularly helps young men explore a possible call to the priesthood.



Duncan Mitchell - Duncan has been a member of the Cor et Lumen Christi Community for over 10 years. After graduating with a degree in Law Duncan qualified as a social worker and for a number of years specialised in work with drug and alcohol users.
