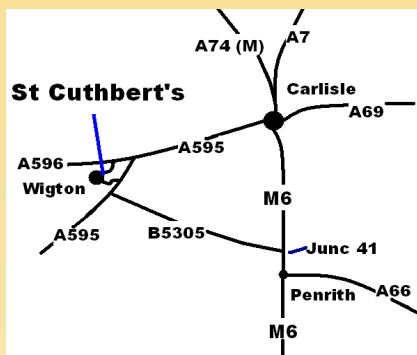

Train - From Carlisle to Wigton takes
15 minutes. St Cuthbert's
is a short walk from the station.



Car - From the North and North East enter Carlisle from the A7, M6 or A69 and follow signs for the A595 and West. At Thursby roundabout take A596, after 5 miles turn left at the first sign into Wigton. St Cuthbert's is on the right at the bottom of the hill, between the school and the church.

From the South leave M6 at J41 (north of Penrith), follow B5305 into Wigton. At the T-junction next to the monument turn right, we are at the bottom of the hill on left between the church and school just after Lidl.

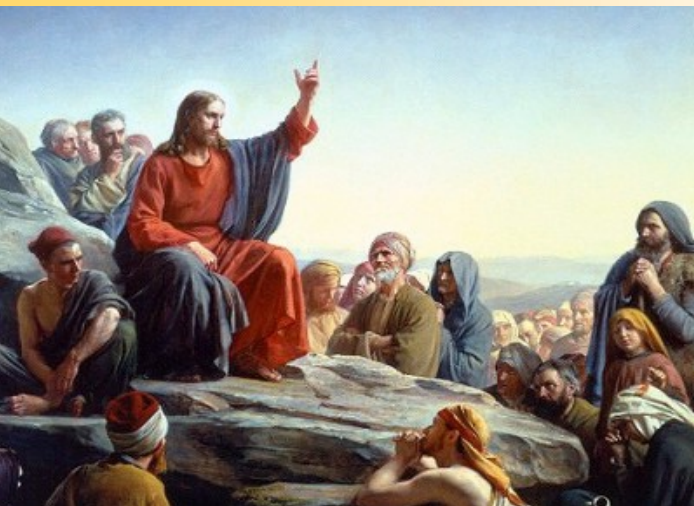
“..and Jesus said the Kingdom of God is close at hand..” Mark1 v15
