**Car:** Come off the M25 junction 11, then follow map. Parking available in surrounding streets. Please note there is NO parking at Highfield House.

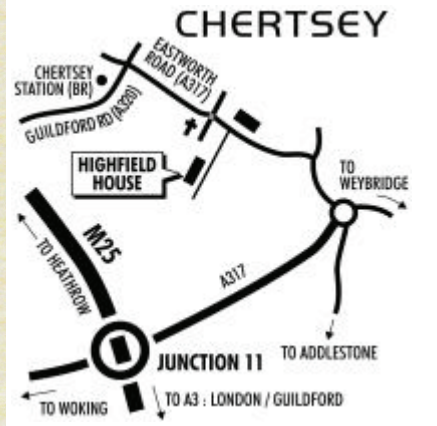
**Cost?** DONATION ONLY

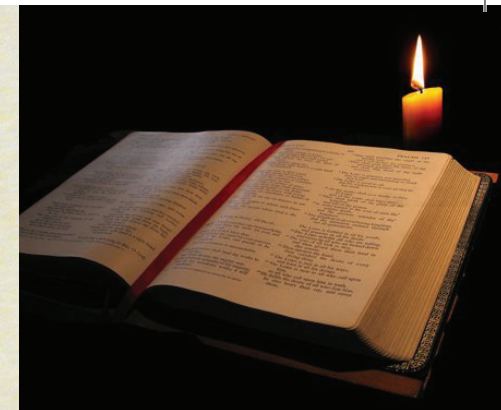
